



THE ST. OLAF BAND JAPAN TOUR 2010

The St. Olaf Band will tour Japan for two weeks this January. In addition to performing concerts around the country, members of the band will be completing a college course examining the history and culture of Japan. As part of their studies they will attend a Japanese theater performance and visit the great palaces, temples, and museums of Tokyo, Nara, Osaka, Kyoto, and Hiroshima.

From its earliest days the St. Olaf Band has toured nationally and internationally on a regular basis. Under conductor Timothy Mahr's baton, the St. Olaf Band toured Norway in 1996 and 2005, Britain and Ireland in 2000, and took a study tour of Mexico in 2004.
