



Summer 2010 Parking & Permits

Summer is here and those students who will be staying on campus to study or work for the summer will need to obtain a Summer Parking Permit from the Parking Office (Administration Building 114). There is no reason to not get a summer permit—after all, they are free! That’s right—there is no cost to students for summer permits!

As during the academic year, the parking policy is still in effect, and there are two types of summer permits for students—one for those living on campus and another for those living off campus.

On-campus permits are to park in Skoglund Lot, Lot I, Lot J, or Lincoln Lot. Even though Mohn Hall is the summer residence hall, at this time there are not any on-campus permits allowed to park in Lot C (Commuter Lot) next to the building.

Off-campus permits can park in either of the two commuter lots—Lot C or by Hill/Kitt. Signs are posted labeling EACH of the areas as Commuter Parking.

Due to the various conferences and events that will be held on campus throughout the summer, it is extremely important that students park where their permit allows and not take up faculty/staff/visitor spaces that will be needed by others.
